

## **Attention All Students**

### **NEW Criteria for Honor Rolls and Honor Societies effective August 2010**

#### **HONOR ROLL**

Honor roll status is achieved when a student achieves a quarter grade point average of **3.25** or above. High honor roll status is achieved when a student achieves a quarter grade point average of **3.75** or above. Honors lists will be posted and published at the end of each quarter. A grade of any kind of "D" or "F" disqualifies a student from academic honors.

#### **HONOR SOCIETY**

##### Criteria for Classes through 2013

To be eligible for the Honor Society, the student must maintain a semester grade point average of 3.00 or above for each semester with the exception of one semester in which a minimum GPA of 2.75 is allowed. To be eligible for the High Honor Society, the student must maintain a semester grade point average of 3.5 or above for each semester with the exception of one semester in which a minimum GPA of 2.75 is allowed.

##### Criteria for class the of 2014 and beyond

To be eligible for the Honor Society, the student must maintain a semester grade point average of 3.25 or above for each semester. To be eligible for the High Honor Society, the student must maintain a semester grade point average of 3.75 or above for each semester.

These changes will not affect students' ability to qualify for college scholarships since scholarship status is typically based on GPA and/or ACT or SAT test scores, not on being named to the honor roll and/or to honor society.

These changes also would not impact auto insurance discounts for qualified young drivers because the minimum requirement is still a "B" and/or a 3.0 average.
