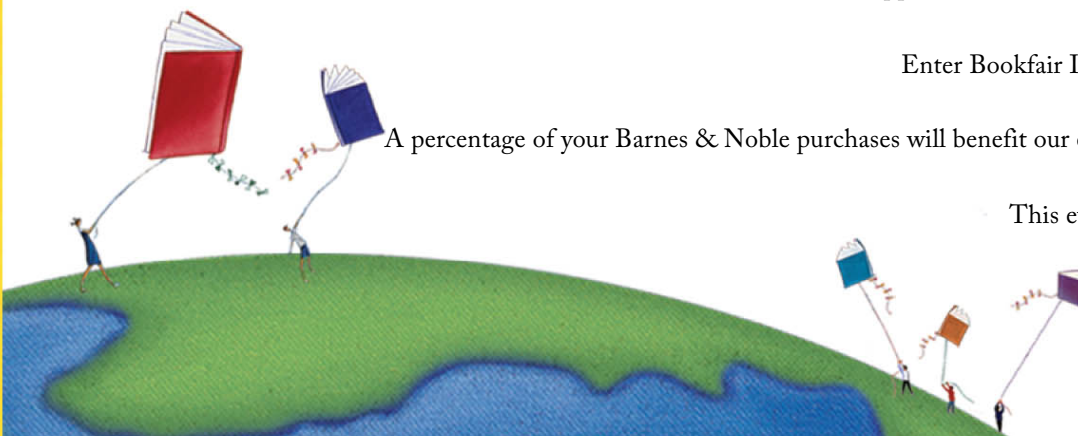

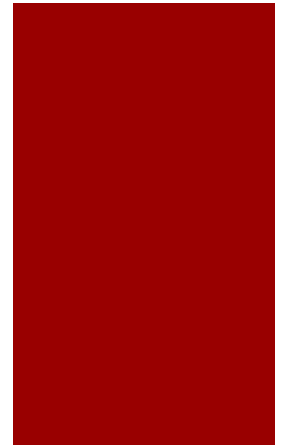
100th Anniversary Cookbook
