## Let's do lunch.

There is an exciting new opportunity to volunteer weekly in an elementary classroom and give our teachers the much-needed chance to hold grade-level meetings during the school day instead of after school.

We are looking for parents who would be willing to act as Classroom Lunch Monitors. Lunch Monitors volunteer in the classroom one time per week, during the 20-minute lunch period from 12:00 to 12:20 p.m., and ensure that children are safe and supervised while they eat their lunch. At the conclusion of the lunch period they ensure the students put on appropriate outerwear - at least in the coming months - and then dismiss them for recess.

If you choose, you may read a book to the students while they eat, or you may simply be in the classroom with them. You would need to arrive at the classroom several minutes before the start of the lunch period and stay with the students until they are dismissed for recess at the conclusion of the lunch period. All Classroom Lunch Monitors will be given written classroom rules and policies.

Wednesday - 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade

Thursday - Kindergarten and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade

### 1. Box Tops for Education



Box Tops for Education proofs of purchase can be found on thousands of products including products made by: Ziploc, Kleenex, Hefty, Betty Crocker, Avery Office Supplies, Welch's, Pilsbury and many, many more.

Timothy receives \$.10 for every box top you turn in and those box tops add up! Timothy has earned \$1,667 so far this year and we are ranked 115 by earnings out of the 5,936 schools that are registered for the program in the state of Illinois.

You can drop off box tops in the collection boxes located in all school offices.

### 2. Campbell's Labels for Education



Campbell's Labels for Education proofs of purchase can be found on Campbell's soups, Post cereals, Bic pens, Pepperidge Farms crackers and cookies, Prego spaghetti sauces, Swanson frozen foods and V8 beverages.

Timothy receives points for every proof of purchase we submit and those points can be redeemed for educational tools, sporting equipment and art supplies.

All Labels for Education proofs of purchase can be dropped off in the Elementary School or High School office.

### 3. Ultra Foods



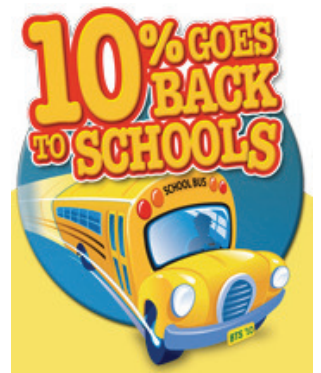
The Ultra Foods program has been extended! Timothy will continue to receive 5% of your receipt total (excluding alcohol and tobacco) for receipts dated between January 1 and May 31, 2011. You are also welcome to submit friends and relative's receipts too. Ultra just asks that you don't collect receipts at the store. Please drop off your receipts in the office.

### 4. Dominick's Fresh Values Card

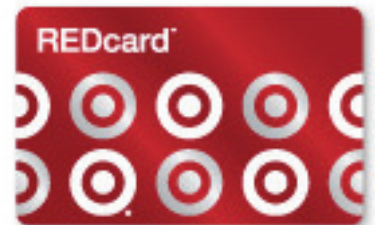
The Dominick's Fresh Values Card is a free loyalty program for Dominick's shoppers. You can link your Dominick's Fresh Values Card to Timothy by visiting: [www.escrip.com](http://www.escrip.com) and selecting the link in the lower left corner that says, "RENEW YOUR COMMITMENT TO SAFEWAY STORES TODAY."



Additionally, from January 2 to January 25, 2011, when you purchase products at Dominick's marked with a yellow school bus, Timothy will receive 10% of the purchase price if you use your escrip-registered Dominick's card at check out.

### 5. Target REDcard

The Target REDcard is a debit card that can only be used at Target and takes funds from your checking account just as writing a check would. You can also use it to get up to \$40 cash back at checkout. Every single time you use the Target REDcard you save 5% off your purchase and 1% is donated to Timothy.



If you already have a Target REDcard you can go online and link it to Timothy.
